1 Passenger	130	195	Same crew may make multiple runs on the same day.
2 Through Freight	130	130	Multiple car train operating between principal terminals, usually with few, if any, stops to set out, pickup, or switch cars. May have different crews beginning at terminals along the route. Example: Crew 1 takes train from point A (origin) to point B. Crew 2 picks up train at point B and takes it to point C, etc. until train arrives at the destination.
8 Converted Through Freight	130	130	Same as Through Freight except earns higher rate by picking up and/or setting off cars at no less than three locations along the route. Or, if at one location for more than 1 hour. Through Freight rate is 'converted' to Local Freight rate.
3 Mine Run	100	100	Multiple car 'unit' train runs from origin to turn point and back to origin. Pulls loaded cars from mines and returns empties. Has assigned off days.
4 Road Switcher	100	100	A road assignment that spots, pulls, and classifies cars within a terminal or industrial area.
5 Yard	100	100	Switches cars to and from industries within the yard limits. Lines up cars for road trains. Works 1st, 2nd and 3rd shifts with regular assigned off day(s).
6 Local Freight	100	100	Trains which originate and terminate on CSXT tracks and involve no other railroad. Has assigned off days.
9 Work/Wreck	100		A train assigned to serve the maintenance-of-way department in track repair and maintenance. Also assists in cleanup of derailment site.
